



Turning Circle: A Guide for Families

Drop-off and pick-up — please read and share with anyone who drives your child to school.

Our turning circle is designed to keep congestion away from Moorway Lane, reduce risk to students, and allow everyone to drop off and collect more quickly and safely. Thank you for taking the time to read this guide and doing what you can to keep our children safe.

How to use the turning circle

- 1** Move into the Drop Off lane (left-hand lane). This is the only lane where you should stop.
- 2** Do not stop or park in the No Stop lane (right-hand lane). It must be kept clear at all times for other vehicles to pass.
- 3** Students exit on the left-hand side of the vehicle. Check surroundings carefully before opening the door and stepping out.
- 4** Check for passing vehicles before moving out. Make sure there is not a vehicle in the no stopping lane before you drive away.

QUICK REMINDER

- ✓ Stop only in the Drop Off lane (left)
- ✓ Never stop or park in the No Stop lane (right)
- ✓ Children exit on the left, checking surroundings first
- ✓ Leave space for other vehicles to pass, then move off
